## The Rev Dr L. William Countryman

is an Episcopal priest, noted author and Sherman E. Johnson Professor Emeritus in Biblical Studies at Church Divinity School of the Pacific, Berkeley, California.

Ordained a priest in the Diocese of Oklahoma in 1965, he served parishes and chaplaincies in Oklahoma, Ohio, Illinois, and Missouri. He is actively involved in ministry at Good Shepherd Episcopal Church in Berkeley.

Countryman writes and speaks on a wide variety of topics. He is perhaps best known for *Dirt, Greed, and Sex*, a study of sexual ethics in the New Testament and today, and for *Living on the Border of the Holy*, which explores the nature of ministry, lay and ordained. Other books include *Interpreting the Truth: Changing the Paradigm of Biblical Studies*, which argues for better conversation between church and academy.

Countryman has explored the issue of spirituality in works such as *The Mystical Way in the Fourth Gospel, Forgiven and Forgiving, The Poetic Imagination: An Anglican Spiritual Tradition*, and *Love Human and Divine*. He is co-author with the late M. R. Ritley of *Gifted by Otherness: Gay and Lesbian Christians in the Church*.

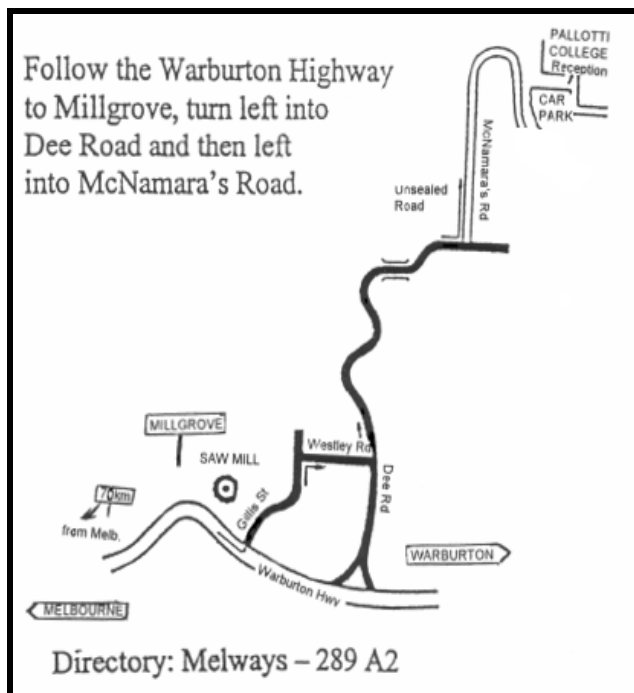

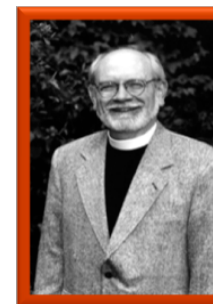
